

Uniform Procedures for
Anne Chesnutt Middle School

- Shirts:** Shirts must be a plain white polo or oxford and **MUST BE TUCKED IN AT ALL TIMES.**
- T-Shirts:** T-shirts worn under the uniform shirt must be **WHITE.**
- Slacks:** Slacks must be khaki (tan) and must be worn on the hip.
- Belts:** Leather belts will be worn at all times in all pants, shorts, or skirts with belt loops. ***No oversize belt buckles.***
- Shorts:** Shorts must be khaki (tan) and must be worn on the hip. Shorts must be at or near the knee
- Skirts:** Skirts, Jumpers, and Skorts must be khaki (tan) and must be worn at or near the knee or longer.
- Shoes:** Dress, casual or tennis shoes with a closed toe and closed heel ***must*** be worn.
- Socks:** ***Only*** solid white socks must be worn.
- Turtlenecks:** White turtlenecks ***MUST*** be worn underneath a uniform polo, oxford, sweater, or sweatshirt.
- Sweaters:** **Plain** knit sweaters must be worn as pullovers, cardigans, or vests in the ***SOLID*** uniform color of **WHITE** over a uniform polo, oxford, or turtleneck with the ***collar showing.***
- Sweatshirts And Fleece:** Only **PLAIN SOLID** uniform colors of **WHITE** sweatshirts or fleece pullovers zip-up sweatshirts or fleece may be worn over a uniform polo, oxford, or turtleneck.
- Jackets:** Students may wear during the day jackets purchased from Anne Chesnutt Middle School. All other coats, jackets and **NON-UNIFORM** colored sweatshirts, hooded sweatshirt jackets; fleece pullovers and sweaters must be stored in the locker.

Guidelines for Physical Education

Dressing out for PE means changing from regular school clothes into a PE uniform and then changing back into regular school clothes after PE class. Gym clothes are not to be worn underneath other clothing nor are they to be worn outside of the gym class. PE uniforms consist of:

- Gym shorts ***at or near the knee***
- Tee shirts – ***no tank tops or spaghetti straps***
- Warm-up pants or jogging pants
- Socks
- Athletic shoes properly laced

The administration has discretion in making judgments relating to the appropriateness of dress to include jewelry. The appearance of our student body reflects upon the climate of our school. Students are expected to adhere to standards of dress and grooming that are acceptable in a positive learning environment.
